### Rules for Competitions

1. There will be parallel competitions.
2. Participants can participate in any number of competitions.
3. Judges decisions will be final
4. Representatives of each competitions are requested to be present during the time of drawing the lot.

### THEME DANCE

#### Theme: Health: issues & ways forward

1. One team from one college (7 to 10 members including the supporting artists) can participate in the competition.
2. Time allotted for each team is 12 minutes including stage arrangements.
3. Eco-friendly properties are encouraged to be used for stage and background settings.
4. No other light arrangements are allowed other than the lights arranged by the organizers on stage.
5. USB enclosed with music should be submitted at the time of competition registration.
6. Criteria for evaluation: - Theme Presentation, Creativity , Costumes & Choreography

7. The properties used on the stage have to be cleared immediately after the dance by the team itself.
8. The team representative should report at the time of drawing the lot at the registration counter, when notified.

## STREET PLAY

### Theme: On the Spot

1. One team from a college (7 to 10 members including the supporting artists) can participate in the competition.
2. There are two stages for this competition: a) Script Writing Stage, b) Performing Stage
3. Time allocated for street play is maximum 15 minutes.
4. Topic related to Health will be given on the spot and participants are expected to write the script & practice the same and perform it on the next day.
5. There will be no shortlisting based on the script however, it is mandatory to submit the same before the commencement of the street play.
6. Medium of language can be either English or Malayalam.
7. Instruments and costumes should be arranged by the team itself.
8. Criteria for evaluation: theme presentation creativity, team work, message, Marks of round 1
9. The team representative should be present at the time of drawing the lot.
10. The script of street play submitted to organisers belongs to DiST

## PROJECT PROPOSAL

### Theme: On the Spot

1. One team from each college consisting of 4 members, in which two members each in each stages can participate in the competition.
2. Topic will be given on the spot
3. There are two stages for this competition: a) Data Hunt, b) Proposal Writing
4. In the first stage participants are expected to collect the literature necessary for writing the proposal (first two members) and in the second stage based on the literature collected, participants have to write the proposal (remaining two members).
5. Proposal must be in printed form
6. Resources to prepare the project will be available at the venue
7. Time allotted for each stage is one hour
8. The submitted proposal belongs to the organisers
9. The criteria for evaluation: quality of the literature, feasibility of the project, budget & Sustainability

## PHOTOGRAPHY

### Theme: On the spot

1. Team of two from each college can participate in this competition
2. Topic will be given on the spot and participants are expected to capture a photo on the given time frame and suggest a caption for the same.

3. There are two stages for this competition: a) Photo Capture, b) Photo Display
4. Time allotted for first round is 2 hour and second round is 2 minutes
5. Participants have to submit the captured photo after two hour and same will be displayed through LCD projector in the main auditorium for evaluation.
6. Participants are expected to bring Camera of any pixel for capturing of the photo
7. Criteria for evaluation: justify the theme, caption, creativity & innovation
8. Authenticity of the photograph will be strictly verified.
9. Time and date of capturing the snap should be displayed on the photo.

## BEST SOCIAL WORKER

A team of 2 members from each college can participate in the event. There will be **three stages** for the competition – Qualifying Round, Social Work Quiz & Hit the Jackpot. Screening will be done after each stage. More details of this event will be disclosed just before the competition.

### **STAGE 1 – QUALIFYING ROUND**

1. A computer test will be conducted on the basics of social work.
2. There will be screening after this round

### **SSTAGE II – SOCIAL WORK QUIZ**

1. Participants can refer UGC NET questions and answers & current affairs
2. There will be different rounds
3. There will be screening after this round

### **STAGE III – HIT THE JACKPOT**

1. This stage includes three rounds. Joke n Roll, Trade your Traits and Rapid Question.
2. Medium of language can either be in English or Malayalam.

## SOCIAL CASE WORK

### **Theme: (On the spot)**

1. A team of two from each college can participate in this competition
2. Topic will be given on the spot and based on the topic, participants are expected to prepare a case work record (imaginary or real) in a verbatim form, which shall be neatly written on the given time.
3. Total time for this competition is 1 hour 30 minutes
4. There are two stages for this competition: a) Social Case work recording ( 1 hour), b) Social Case Work Presentation (in ppt, maximum 8 minutes)
5. There will be screening after the first round
6. Logistics required will be provided.
7. Criteria for evaluation: assessment, questioning skills, intervention, overall quality
